



## High School Information (Grades 9-12)

### **Academics:**

A variety of publishers are utilized for our students including Abeka, Bob Jones, Saxon and others. The administration and faculty strive to provide the best academic curriculum to the students of SJCA. All students have Bible as a class each day. San Jacinto Christian Academy is accredited by the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI). This accreditation ensures that colleges will accept SJCA high school credits on par with public and private schools. High School students in grades 9 – 11 take the Stanford Achievement Test annually. Sophomore and Junior students take the PSAT annually. SJCA offers a variety of pre-AP, AP, honor and dual credit courses.

### **Athletics:**

SJCA has a rich and diverse athletic program. High school students may choose to participate in the following sports: football, volleyball, cross-country, basketball (boy's and girl's), golf, tennis, softball, baseball, swimming and cheerleading.

### **Chapel:**

All students attend chapel once a week. Elementary, Middle School and High School each have a separate chapel service.
